### *Gliding*

To the time of going to press the following gliding certificates have been obtained:

- "A" Certificates—145 cadets, 12 officers.
- "B" Certificates—7 cadets, 6 officers.
- "C" Certificates—3 officers.

Many detachments have suffered from very bad weather, and a large number of cadets have been on the point of obtaining their "A" Certificates at the end of their course, and have only been prevented by weather conditions.

### *Adjutant—Duties and Responsibilities*

We are periodically asked to describe the duties of an adjutant; they are as follows:

The general duty of the adjutant is to assist his commanding officer, and to see that his instructions and wishes are carried out by all ranks. He should attend to all purely routine matters with a view to giving his commanding officer more time to study the general efficiency of the unit. He is responsible for, and must generally supervise, office routine, and co-ordinate the work of all branches, including equipment. It is his duty to report to his commanding officer any irregularities which come to his notice, either officially or otherwise. He is responsible for drawing the attention of the commanding officer to all orders that affect the squadron.


### *Badges for Warrant Officer*

The uniform worn by a warrant officer is the same as that for an ordinary officer of the Corps, with the exception of the badge of rank.

We now hold in stock at headquarters a supply of worsted cadet warrant officers' badges. These badges are worn 6½ inches from the bottom of the sleeve to the centre of the badge, on both sleeves. The design is an Air League bird enclosed in a laurel wreath.

Orders for these should be sent to headquarters, the cost of each badge being 1s. 6d.

### 34F and 82 (Wandsworth) Squadrons

#### AIR CADETS RECEIVE NEW STANDARDS

Gifts of  
Ald. G. F. Morris and Lieut.-Col. A. Bellamy  
Dedication Ceremony by Bishop of Kingston  
Sir John Salmond takes Salute

King George's Park, Wandsworth, was the scene last (Thursday) night of a memorable ceremony consisting of the dedication and presentation of the standards to the 34th (F) and 82nd Wandsworth Squadrons of the Air Defence Cadet Corps.

The standard for the 34th Squadron was presented by Alderman G. F. Morris, and that for the 82nd Squadron by Lieut.-Col. A. Bellamy, T.D., D.L., J.P., L.C.C.

The dedication service was conducted by the Bishop of Kingston, and Sir John Salmond, G.C.B., C.M.G., C.V.O., D.S.O., Marshal of the Royal Air Force, took the salute, and inspected the squadrons.

Among those also present were a number of visiting Mayors and Mayoresses, together with Wing-Commander Grice, D.F.C., Squadron-Leader Prickman, and other officers from Biggin Hill, to which the Wandsworth Squadrons are affiliated.

Between 500 and 600 cadets were on parade, and it is estimated that nearly 5,000 people were present at King George's Park.

The Cadet Squadrons assembled at Trinity Road, Wandsworth Common, and, headed by the band of the 42nd Battalion Royal Tank Corps, marched off in the following order: 34th (F) Squadron, Wandsworth; 82nd (F) Squadron, Wandsworth; 18th (F) Squadron, Wimbledon; 33rd (F) Squadron, Battersea; 39th (F) Squadron, Barnes and Richmond; 46th (F) Squadron, Kensington; 50th (F) Squadron, Lambeth; and 66th, 79th, and 97th Squadrons, Croydon.

Upon arrival at King George's Park, the Squadrons were inspected by Sir John Salmond,

accompanied by the Mayor (Councillor Wm. C. Bonney, J.P.), Lieut.-Col. A. Bellamy, and Alderman G. F. Morris.

The service for the dedication of the standards was then proceeded with. After the singing of the hymn, "Soldiers of Christ, Arise," Alderman Morris asked the Bishop, on behalf of the Wandsworth Squadrons of Air Defence Cadets, to "bid God's blessing on these standards."

In asking God's blessing on the standards, the Bishop said: "Let us pray Almighty God of His mercy to grant that they may never be unfurled, save in the cause of justice and righteousness; and that He may make them to be to those who follow them a sign of His presence in all dangers and distresses, and so increase their faith and hope in Him who is King of kings and Lord of lords."

The dedication of the standards followed. Laying his hand on the standards, the Bishop said: "In the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, we do consecrate and set apart these standards, that they may be a sign of our duty towards our King and country in the sight of God."

The hymn, "O God, our help in ages past," was then sung.

The Bishop, in his address, said that a true Christian should love his King and country, and do all he could for it, for he owed everything to his country and must endeavour to do his duty for it. The standards represented to them their duty towards their Sovereign and their country. He prayed that they might never be unfurled, save in the cause of justice and righteousness, and that He might make them to be to those who follow them a sign of His presence in all dangers and distresses, and so increase their faith and hope in Him.

God's favour would rest on those who would follow the standards which were to be committed to their trust. Might their courage ever rest on their sure confidence in God.

#### Presentation of Standards

The 34th (F) and 82nd Wandsworth Squadrons lined up in front of the saluting base with accompanying detachments in the rear. The

drums were piled and the standards laid upon them. The band then played "Land of Hope and Glory."

The presenters, Alderman G. F. Morris and Lieut.-Col. A. Bellamy, accompanied by the Mayor of Wandsworth and Sir John Salmond, walked to the drums and presented the standards to the Commanding Officers of the 34th (F) and 82nd Squadrons respectively. In making their respective presentations, Alderman Morris and Col. Bellamy said: "I present this standard to your squadron, of which the burgesses are justly proud. I hope it may help you to remember that all your aims should be for God, King and country, and that at all times you will strive for 'honour without blemish'."

The colour party accepted the standards.

The colours were received by Flight-Lieut. Roy Turner and Flight-Lieut. Appleton with a general salute, and then trooped.

The band played "Sons of the brave."

At the conclusion of the ceremony the cadets marched past and the salute was taken by Sir John Salmond, accompanied by the Mayor, Alderman G. F. Morris, and Lieut.-Col. A. Bellamy.

During the evening a flight from Biggin Hill, flew past.

#### No. 28F (Bishop Wordsworth's School) Squadron

No. 28F (Bishop Wordsworth's School) Squadron Air Defence Cadets is now firmly established as a section of the company of service. It consists of two flights officered by prefects of the school with the rank of cadet flight-lieutenants. Efficient technical instruction has been given during the last two terms by officers and N.C.O.s of the R.A.F. School of Army Co-operation, Old Sarum. Some of the most valuable instruction has been carried out with the aid of a cinema. A room in the school buildings has been set aside for the use of cadets, and has been equipped with diagrams, maps, books, periodicals and aeroplane photographs.

The squadron paraded as part of the company of service on Founder's Day and were presented with Colours, a pennon of Air Force blue, royal blue and white, with the crest of the Air Defence Cadets emblazoned on it, by Group Capt. J. Cole-Hamilton, of the R.A.F. School of Army Co-operation, Old Sarum. The turn-out and steadiness on parade were of high standard, and the march-past smartly carried out. Twelve cadets of the squadron attended a gliding course conducted by the Oxford University and City Gliding Club at Aston Rowant from 1st to 14th August.

#### No. 96 (Dewsbury) Squadron

The above squadron is now up to strength of one hundred cadets and also has a long waiting list.

Every cadet has been medically examined, and as over eighty per cent hope to join the R.A.F. later on, this examination has been made a stiff one.

As about twenty per cent will leave each year, the ages of those selected have been most carefully considered, with a view to keeping the squadron properly balanced. The majority of the officers are ex-R.F.C. or R.A.F. pilots, whilst the Sergeant-Major and Flight-Sergeants are all men who served in those ranks during the Great War. Two parades are held per week, and on one of these about an hour's P.T. is given by a fully-qualified instructor, whose diversified training not only holds the interest of the cadets but improves their carriage and physique.

The attendances are usually over ninety per cent, which speaks well for the keenness of the cadets, as many of them are shop assistants, mill and pit hands, etc. The first twenty to be fitted with uniform were on duty at Doncaster Airport during Empire Air Day, where they were very useful, although they had only had a very brief lesson on how to form fours!

A party of ten have already been on a gliding course at Welburn Aerodrome, and, although the weather was truly terrible, three of them showed great promise. Cadet S/L. T. H. Newsome obtained his "A" and "B" licences on August 2nd, but unfortunately had to make a forced landing whilst attempting to obtain his "C" licence, owing to a sudden change in the weather.

The squadron is affiliated at Finningley, and their C.O., Wing-Commander L. G. Nixon, is co-operating with us to the fullest extent. He has been over to see the squadron at work, has inspected and addressed them, and instituted a series of lectures by his officers and N.C.O.s which are of great interest and advantage to the cadets.

He is firmly of the opinion that in case of war the squadron would be of great assistance to him, and on the 19th of this month "A" and "B" Flights are to visit their affiliated Squadron for practical instruction.

As we are not well equipped financially, the officers of Finningley are paying for the transportation of the cadets and also providing them with a meal. This is a very generous gesture on their part, and augurs well for the future.

### No. 13F (Exeter) Squadron

During the past term the general activities of the cadets were somewhat restricted by the demands of education and the shadow of examinations.

In the first place we welcome the appointment of Mr. D. Paling as a flight-lieutenant. He is taking an active and keen interest in our work and will be sharing in the summer camp duties.

The course of engineering lectures commenced in January was duly completed, and the cadets had a written examination on the elementary principles of the aero-engine.

The Morse signalling class continues to make steady and satisfactory progress, whilst the drill parades have revealed a marked improvement in general smartness and quickness of movement.

We are greatly indebted to the Commandant of the Exeter R.A.F. Volunteer Reserve, who has kindly arranged lectures by experts on his staff and is also offering facilities for practical demonstrations and flights at the local airport.

On Empire Day a party of thirty cadets journeyed to Plymouth, where they attended the display given by our affiliated squadron at Mount Batten, and passed a very enjoyable and instructive afternoon.

The local division of the Wessex Signals, where our Morse classes are held, have very kindly allowed us to use their miniature range for shooting one evening per week, and this is proving very popular.

We are eagerly looking forward to our summer camps. Everything is in readiness for the gliding camp at Church Stretton, and

arrangements are well under way for a flight of cadets to spend a week under canvas at Mount Batten, where, thanks to the generosity of our parent squadron, it is hoped to obtain some insight into the routine life of the Royal Air Force.

### No. 59 (Huddersfield) Squadron

Since the last report the squadron has paraded on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Instruction in Drills, Aero Engines, Theory of Flight and Glider Construction has been given regularly.

On July 27th the N.C.O.s' "passing-out" examination was held when a surprisingly good standard was shown both as regards detail, word of command, observation and general smartness.

One drill night during the month was occupied by a route march through a residential part of the town. This proved satisfactory in every respect.

During the period of this return two cricket matches were arranged, but owing to rain only one was played. A football club is at present being formed and a field sought. It is hoped that an Air Defence Cadet Corps League will be formed, and negotiations to this effect are at present going on between the local squadrons.

Attendances have kept up, eighty per cent and upwards being the average, excepting during the Engineers' Holiday Week, when attendances fell to fifty per cent.

Assistance by the squadron has been rendered to the local A.R.P. bodies, and small parties of cadets have been detailed as messengers, etc., at most of the exercises.

#### Squadron Flag

The size of the squadron flag is left to the discretion of unit commanders, since it depends on where it is to be flown.

Squadron colours are of *one size only*.

#### Blue Overalls

Messrs. H. W. Strank, of 302b Kentish Town Road, London, N.W.5, draw attention to the fact that they can supply blue overalls suitable for cadets. The medium quality are 54s. per dozen, but a cheaper or better quality can be supplied.

#### Flying Instruction—Insurance

Should any cadets undergo flying instruction as cadets, it is necessary that their names should

be forwarded to these headquarters monthly, as an insurance premium, both for personal accident to the cadets and for legal liability, has to be paid by the Air League for each individual.

If the name is notified to the Air League, no further action need be taken by the squadron, and until such notification is made and acknowledged the cadet is not insured.
